Sourced from a north facing, gently sloped hillside at elevation, this Wente clone Chardonnay reflects its cool climate origins, shaped by persistent morning fog and a deliberate, Chablis-inspired winemaking approach. With full malolactic fermentation blocked, the wine preserves its natural acidity and crystalline precision.

The nose is strikingly mineral driven, opening with flint and oyster shell alongside a subtle saline edge. These savory notes are lifted by delicate white peach and hints of lychee, offering both freshness and aromatic intrigue.

Lean and focused, the palate carries a fresh, medium-bodied texture that remains vibrant and racy throughout. Bright acidity frames flavors of ripe grapefruit, lending a citrus-driven core that is both energetic and refined. The wine's tension and linearity are balanced by just enough weight to provide depth without sacrificing precision.

A beautifully restrained Chardonnay that emphasizes minerality, freshness, and structure. Its Chablis-style inspiration shines through in its purity and energy, delivering a clean, lingering finish marked by saline nuance and citrus brightness.
