Perched at 1,800 feet on the rugged slopes of Moon Mountain, this limited-production Sauvignon Blanc reflects both elevation and precision. Planted in 2004, the vineyard imparts a distinctive balance of vibrancy and mineral tension.

An expressive and lifted nose opens with delicate lilac and white blossom, layered with ripe nectarine and a twist of lemon zest. The floral tones are elegant yet vivid, giving way to fresh orchard and citrus notes.

Bright and refreshing on entry, the wine showcases a lively core of honeydew melon, kiwi, and crisp green apple. Its acidity is energetic and mouthwatering, driving a clean, focused structure. Subtle wet stone and nuanced minerality weave through the finish, adding complexity and a sense of place.

A beautifully poised Sauvignon Blanc that captures the high-elevation character of Moon Mountain—fresh, aromatic, and mineral-driven with a precise and refreshing finish.
