2014 Voir Dire is the flagship wine of Theorem Vineyards. Produced from the oldest vines on our Diamond Mountain estate, this 100% Cabernet Sauvignon is a complex, captivating and timeless wine. Built to age, Voir Dire is a stunning reflection of soil and microclimate, full-bodied and supremely balanced with highly extracted black fruit flavors.

The 2014 Voir Dire Cabernet Sauvignon stays true to our mission of expressing the virtues of each unique vintage through the complexity of our hillside old-vine block. The aromas are elegant and polished, offering sweetly toasted caramel, dusty earth, crushed ripe cherry, red currant and Rosemary blossom. On the palate, concentrated flavors of perfectly ripe black cherry, blackberry and a hint of cola commingle with notes of cassis, sandalwood and graphite. The concentration of these flavors gives the wine weight and depth as it rolls over the palate. In contrast, the finely chiseled tannins keeps the flavors focused and push them towards a powerful and lingering finish that leave you waiting for the next sip.
