2018 Voir Dire is the flagship wine of Theorem Vineyards. Produced from the oldest vines on our Diamond Mountain estate, this 100% Cabernet Sauvignon is a complex, captivating and timeless wine. Built to age, Voir Dire is a stunning reflection of soil and microclimate, full-bodied and supremely balanced with highly extracted black fruit flavors.

The 2018 Voir Dire Cabernet Sauvignon's aromas are densly layered and perfumed. Black currants, ripe red plums and fresh boysenberry, swirl alongside notes of pastis, cinnamon and cedar. Fine grained tannins envelop the wine in a gentle embrace, giving it structure and poise. On the palate the wine is plush yet powerful, with flavors that mirror the aromas and have a way of revealing themselves one after the other until the wine builds to a crescendo and crashes to an elongated finish of red plums, toasted cinnamon and black licorice.
