2012 Voir Dire is the flagship wine of Theorem Vineyards. Produced from the oldest vines on our Diamond Mountain estate, this 100% Cabernet Sauvignon is a complex, captivating and timeless wine. Built to age, Voir Dire is a stunning reflection of soil and microclimate, full-bodied and supremely balanced with highly extracted black fruit flavors.

Ripe red and black fruits pepper the aromas of the 2012 Voir Dire. Ripe plums come bounding out first, followed by exuberant notes of macerated strawberries, cherry cola, baked blackberries, warm earth and fresh rose petals. The charm of the 2012 vintage is its giving nature and voluptuous form. The flavors are layered and plush and cascade off the tongue to an opulent finish of ripe berries, fresh currants and sweet herbs. This is a spectacular inaugural vintage and with one sip you will quickly see why we hold this vintage so close to our hearts.
