2013 Voir Dire is the flagship wine of Theorem Vineyards. Produced from the oldest vines on our Diamond Mountain estate, this 100% Cabernet Sauvignon is a complex, captivating and timeless wine. Built to age, Voir Dire is a stunning reflection of soil and microclimate, full-bodied and supremely balanced with highly extracted black fruit flavors.

The hallmarks of the 2013 Napa Valley vintage are freshness and power and the 2013 Voir Dire has that in spades. Lifted aromas of fresh blackberries, violets and wild raspberries are layered on top of notes of ripe tobacco leaf, cedar and graphite. As the wine opens with air it begins to reveal deep aromas of strawberry compote, rhubarb and milk chocolate. The aromas are fresh on the nose and expansive and concentrated on the palate, with a firm grip of tannins that will ensure that this wine will age gracefully for years to come.
