2016 Voir Dire is the flagship wine of Theorem Vineyards. Produced from the oldest vines on our Diamond Mountain estate, this 100% Cabernet Sauvignon is a complex, captivating and timeless wine. Built to age, Voir Dire is a stunning reflection of soil and microclimate, full-bodied and supremely balanced with highly extracted black fruit flavors.

Elegance and refinement are two words that come to mind when talking about our 2016 Voir Dire. A near perfect growing season created lifted aromatics of crème de cassis, fresh picked violets, and warm blackberry pie. The hallmarks of the 2016 vintage were moderately hot days yet cool to cold nights that imparted a freshness and imbued the wine with a graceful elegance. Warms notes of cedar, fresh plums, cinnamon and cherry mostardo are wrapped in silky ripe tannins that give the wine structure and power. The wine crescendos with a finish of ripe plums, fresh black cherries, cinnamon and cassis that linger like the last notes of a symphony. Our 2016 Voir Dire might be the best vintage we have seen thus far.
