2023 DECREE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

VARIETY: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

APPELLATION: Diamond Mountain District AVA, Napa Valley

Crafted from four distinct vineyard blocks spanning two dramatically different soil types—Aiken Loam and Boomer Loam—this Cabernet Sauvignon captures both power and nuance. A blend of three clones and *élevage* in 65% new French oak lends depth and structure while preserving site expression.

The nose is layered and compelling, opening with crushed red brick and earthy mineral tones that evoke the rugged character of Diamond Mountain. Notes of rhubarb and red fruit emerge alongside subtle tertiary elements, creating a complex and evolving bouquet full of intrigue.

Rich yet composed, the palate delivers classic Cabernet Sauvignon character with ripe plum and dark fruits at its core. Accents of ginger spice, cedar, and cigar box add warmth and sophistication. The wine is approachable in its youth, with polished tannins and balanced structure, yet possesses the depth and backbone for extended cellaring.

A structured and expressive Cabernet Sauvignon that bridges immediacy and longevity. The 2023 Decree reflects both the intensity of its mountain origins and the refinement of careful *élevage*, offering a wine of depth, character, and age-worthy appeal.
