From our high-altitude vineyard at 1800 feet in the Moon Mountain AVA, this inaugural Blanc de Blancs reflects both the purity of its mountain origin and the elegance of traditional méthode craftsmanship. The Wente-clone Chardonnay, planted in 2004, delivers bright, focused fruit shaped by cool mountain mornings and rocky volcanic soils.

The aromas are lifted and vibrant with fresh lemon zest, white peach, and a touch of jasmine. On the palate, the wine is driven by racy, refreshing acidity, offering clarity and energy. A subtle depth builds through the mid-palate, supported by fine texture and a clean, deliberate structure. Notes of lean, chalky minerality carry the finish, echoing the vineyard's stony terrain.

Balanced, detailed, and quietly expressive, this first release marks a thoughtful new chapter for Theorem Vineyards, one that honors place, precision, and the promise of this great site.
